The [Autism Child & Family Lab](#) at the Hebrew University is committed to asking questions whose answers will improve the lives of children with autism and other developmental disabilities and their families. Our work focuses on families and systems as mechanisms for understanding and affecting phenotypic heterogeneity. We are part of a national network of sites working with the [Azrieli National Centre for Autism and Neurodevelopment Research](#) at Ben Gurion University committed to exploring the early development of autism.

We are recruiting a clinical research postdoctoral fellow (minimum 50% position with possibility of up to 100%) to coordinate diagnostic evaluations at the heart of an exciting new project.

#### Responsibilities:

- Conduct & supervise gold-standard diagnostic assessments for young children with autism.
- Work closely with graduate students and lab PI on conceptualizing and producing meaningful research based on data already in the lab and data collected through these evaluations.
- Be on campus (Mt. Scopus) at least 2 days a week

#### Qualified candidates:

- Will be licensed clinical or developmental psychologists with התמחות and training on ADOS.
- Have [nearly] completed their PhD in psychology, education, or a relevant field
- Significant expertise in diagnostic evaluations for young children with autism.
- Have proven track records of publications and research productivity
